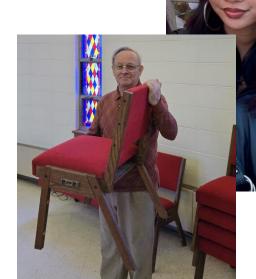


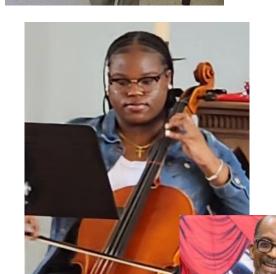




















#### The goal of these pages is for every giver to have:

Pledges – once a year, we ask God's people to make a pledge for the following year.

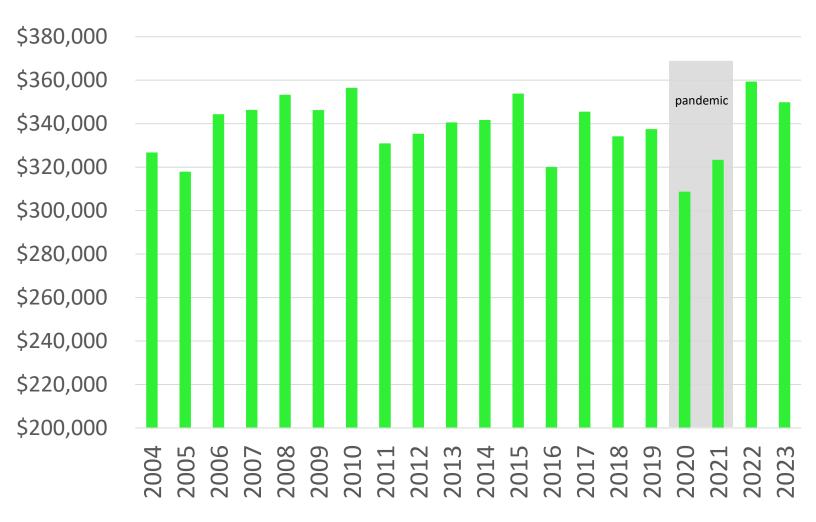
ID'ed (identified) Givers are people who give but haven't pledged

Pledges + IDed givers + Loose Plate

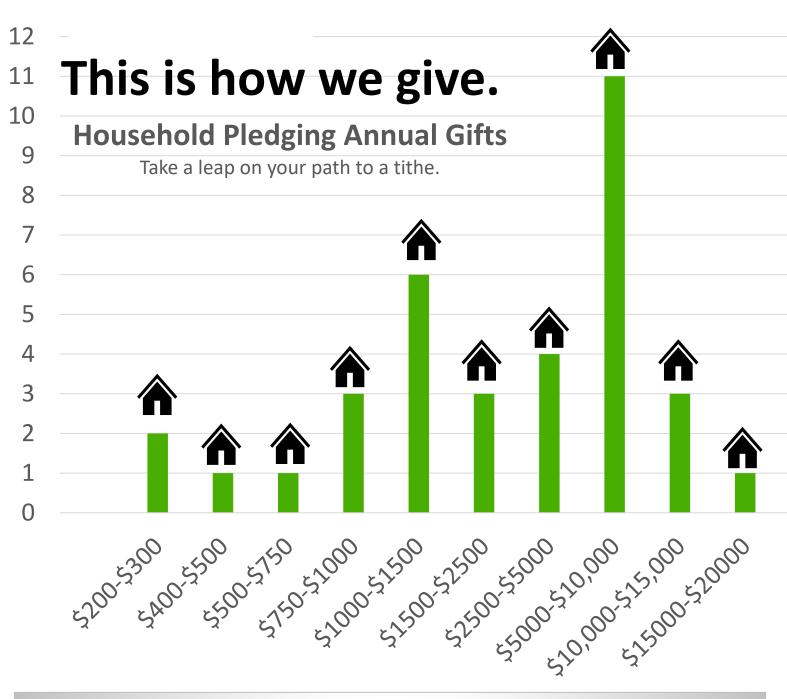


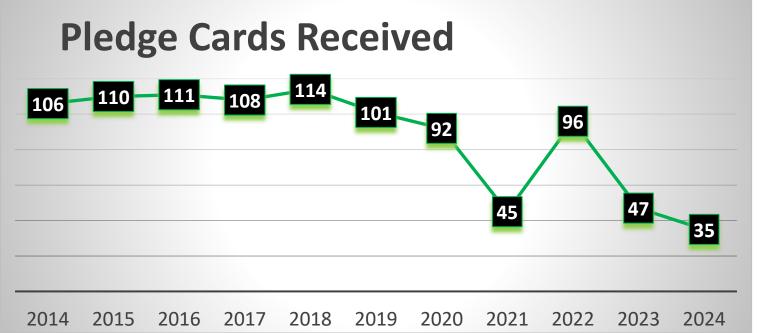
#### Please be in prayer. Over the last four years we have seen

These losses make our ability to maintain giving income levels even more extraordinary. Praise be to God.

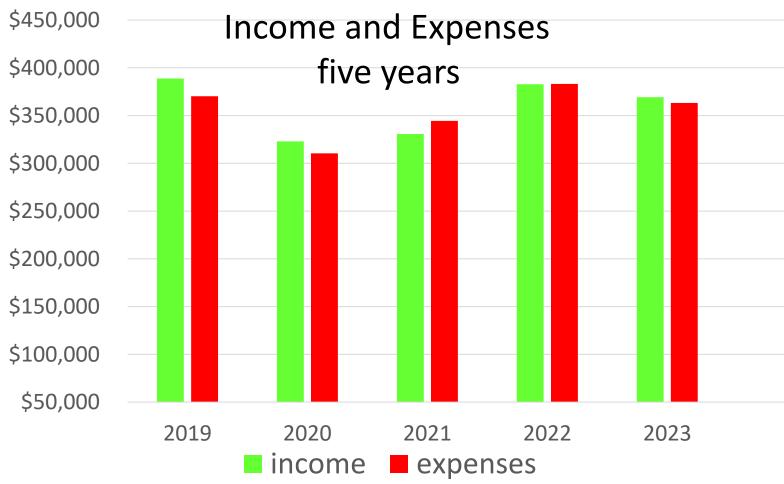


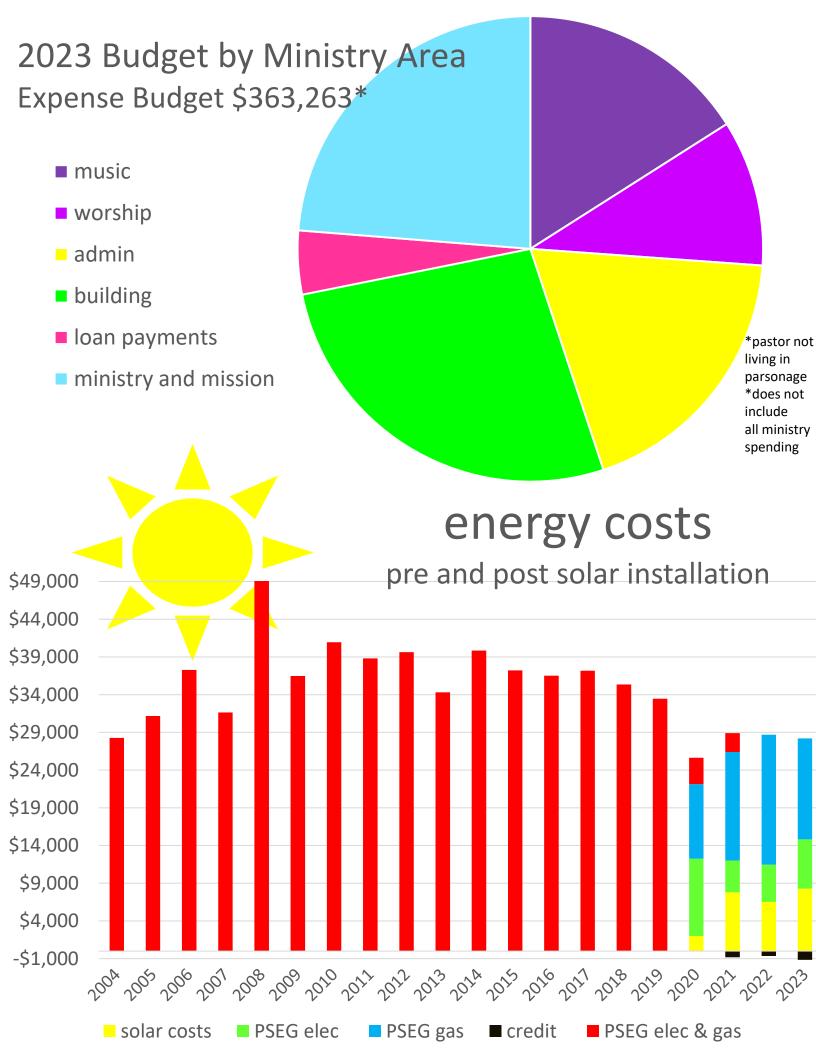




The leadership at Christ UMC has worked hard to keep operating expenses down. Included in the annual expenses are payments on loans that were taken to care for larger building projects and expenses.

Pledge cards Goal: 50 cards

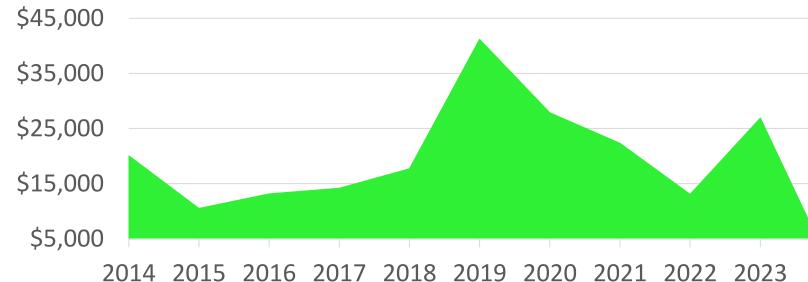
Total Pledges Goal: \$210,000
